



FAST SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

GIVE THE INSTALL SOME TIME, LARGE PACKAGES CAN TAKE UP TO 15 MINUTES TO INSTALL

Your software will come with at least one, or as many as four different DVD's to install. If one is labeled "ArcReader", then install that first. This package is designed to be installed on individual PC hard drives either directly or remotely. You can install on a school network with help from our support pages at www.eMapshop.com. One of the advantages of eMapshop is it's speed versus many of the web based maps. It will run OK on a network but it runs fastest when installed on individual PC hard drives. The license agreement on this software is usually "per building" so feel free to install it on as many computers within your building as you like.

One thing that CAN make your install a problem is Adobe Reader. You MUST have Adobe Reader or some other PDF viewer installed first on the PC before you try to run the eMapshop. You must also pull up some pdf document in the Adobe Reader program to test it and give the Adobe Reader a chance to ask you to accept its license agreement before you try using it in conjunction with the eMapshop. The eMapshop will work fine with Reader 10.x, and higher but refer to our support page for tips and tricks because the map mark-up tools are in a slightly different place

Assuming you have no problem installing the software, the primary operational documentation is a menu item on the disk.

This software is designed to use whatever .pdf reader is specified in the Control Panel, To change that, choose folder options and the file types tab in the Control Panel.

To install, simply place each disk in your CD/DVD drive. If it does not start running the install procedure within a minute, then use your Windows Explorer to navigate to that drive and **double** click on Setup. Depending on the package size, the install will run for 5 ~ 10 minutes while it copies all the maps off the DVD. If you question whether it's still running, just look at the activity light on your DVD. If you have purchased the **Perthes Digital World atlas** as part of your package, then the icon will appear on your desktop. The eMapshop package will ask you just one time where to find the Klett software. Install the Klett disk **first** and take note of where you install it. It can be on the c: drive or a network drive letter. That way you can run it as part of the menu system in the eMapshop. Otherwise, you can still run it, it just runs as a separate piece of software. If you install it on a network please refer to the network installation documentation on www.eMapshop.com Support tab.
