
## Latitude - Lesson 5 - Grade 4-5

Do you remember the starting point for latitude? The Equator is zero (0) degrees. You measure latitude in degrees north and south from the equator. There are 90° of latitude north and 90° of latitude south.

North latitude ends at the North Pole. South latitude ends at the South Pole. The North Pole is 90° north latitude. The South Pole is 90° south latitude.

Find the equator on your globe. Mark 0 on this line. Find the North Pole and mark 90 on or near this location. Write 90 on or near the South Pole. Letter symbols indicate directions. N stands for north, and S stands for south. Find the 180th meridian on your globe It is in the middle of the Pacific Ocean. You will see that lines of latitude are numbered every 10° north and south from the equator.
