Water Features - Lesson 2 - U.S. Political Map Grade 4-5

Objectives To identify and locate various water features on a United States map

Materials Needed A pencil and your map.

Lesson

Water, Water Everywhere

Over 70 percent of the Earth's surface is water. Many different water features can be shown on maps. On your map all water feature names appear in a lettering style called italics. Italic lettering slants to the right. Here are three examples of italic lettering. On your desk map the italic lettering is printed with blue ink.



A **river** is a large stream of water. The river source is its beginning. The river mouth is where the river empties into a larger body of water.

The largest river system in the United States is the <u>Mississippi River</u>. Look at the United States map. Locate the <u>Mississippi River</u>. Trace the <u>Mississippi River</u> from its source in <u>Minnesota</u> to its mouth in <u>Louisiana</u>. Use the United States map to help answer the following questions. Write your answers in the spaces provided.

The <u>Mississippi River</u> has many important **tributaries**. A tributary is a smaller river that empties into a larger one.

- 2. Two important tributaries empty into the <u>Mississippi River</u> near <u>St. Louis</u>, <u>Missouri</u>. What are the names of these two rivers?
- 3. What important <u>Mississippi River</u> tributary's mouth is located at the Illinois, Kentucky and Missouri borders?
- 4. Trace the <u>Ohio River</u> from its source to its mouth. The <u>Ohio River</u> forms boundaries for which states?

- 5. What is the name of the <u>Mississippi River</u> tributary that has its source near Amarillo, Texas?
- 6. Trace the Missouri River from its source near the <u>Montana/Idaho</u> state line to its mouth near <u>St. Louis</u>. What states does the <u>Missouri River</u> flow through. Include the states where the <u>Missouri River</u> forms the state boundaries.

A lake is a body of water that is completely surrounded by land. The largest lakes in the

Gulfs

A **gulf** is a body of water that extends from the ocean or sea into a large indentation of the coastline. The <u>Gulf of Mexico</u> is an example. The <u>Gulf of Mexico</u> is south of <u>Louisiana</u>, <u>Mississippi</u> and <u>Alabama</u>.

Bays

A **bay** is an arm of an ocean, sea or lake usually smaller than a gulf. An example is <u>Appalachia Bay</u>. Look at your United States map. You will find that <u>Appalachia Bay</u> is located south of <u>Tallahassee</u>, <u>Florida</u>. Use your United States map to help you answer the following questions. Write your answers in the spaces provided.
